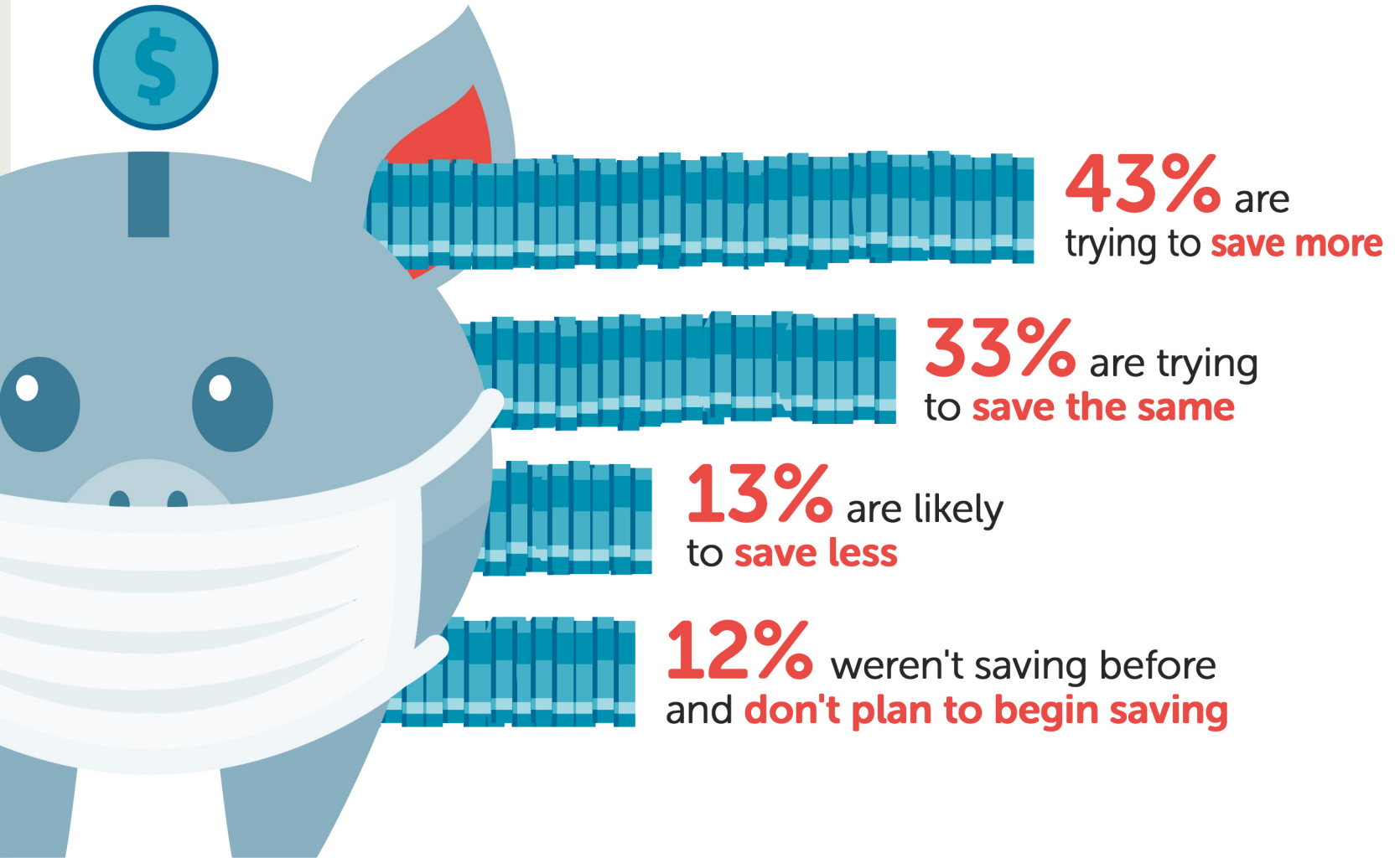

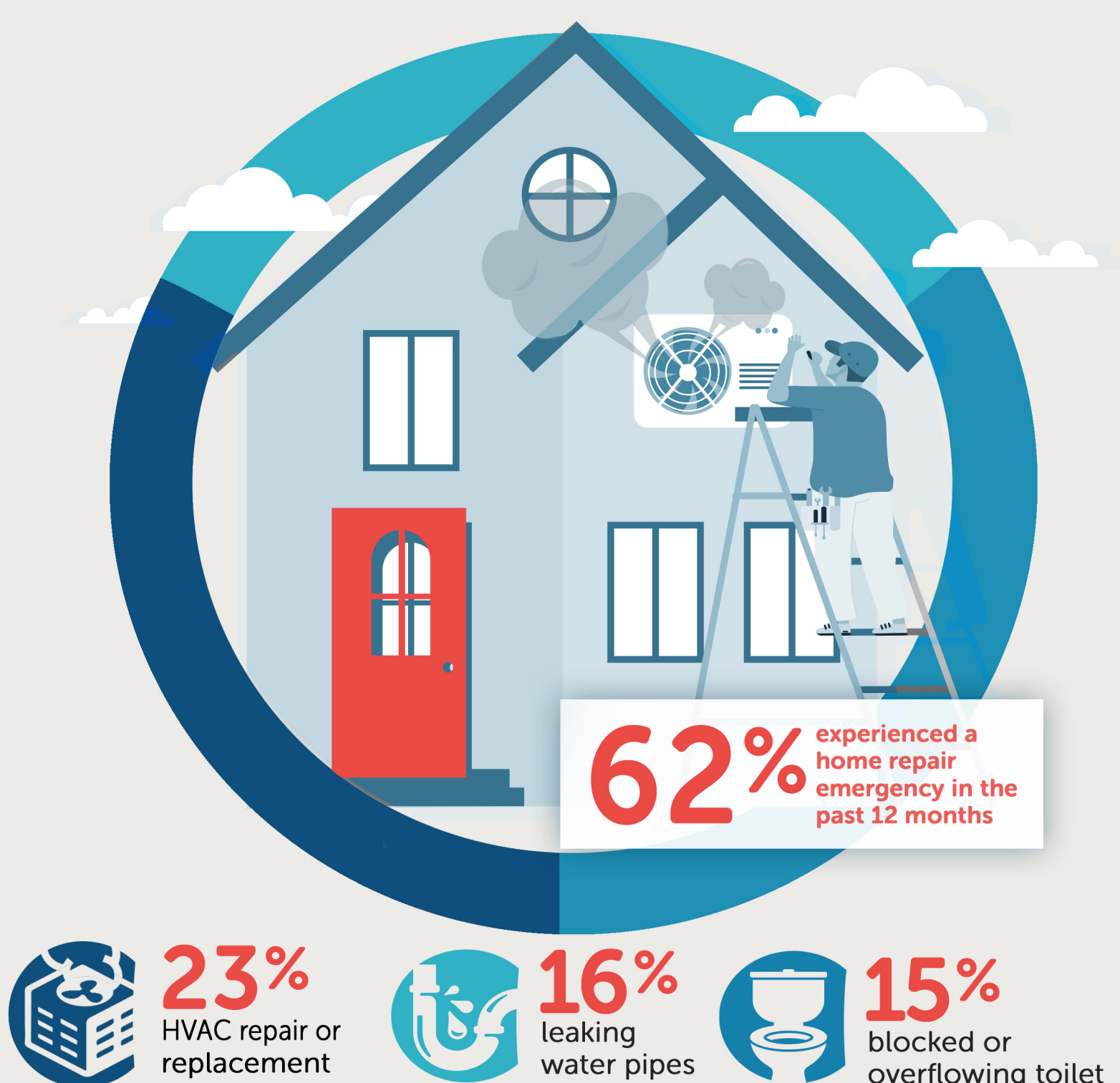

Over seven months into COVID-19, the survey measured the impact of the pandemic on Americans' financial planning strategy. 43% percent say they are now trying to save more for the future. Quarantine may also be taking a toll on homes, with more than 6 out of 10 homeowners (62%) reporting that they have faced some type of home repair emergency over the last 12 months.

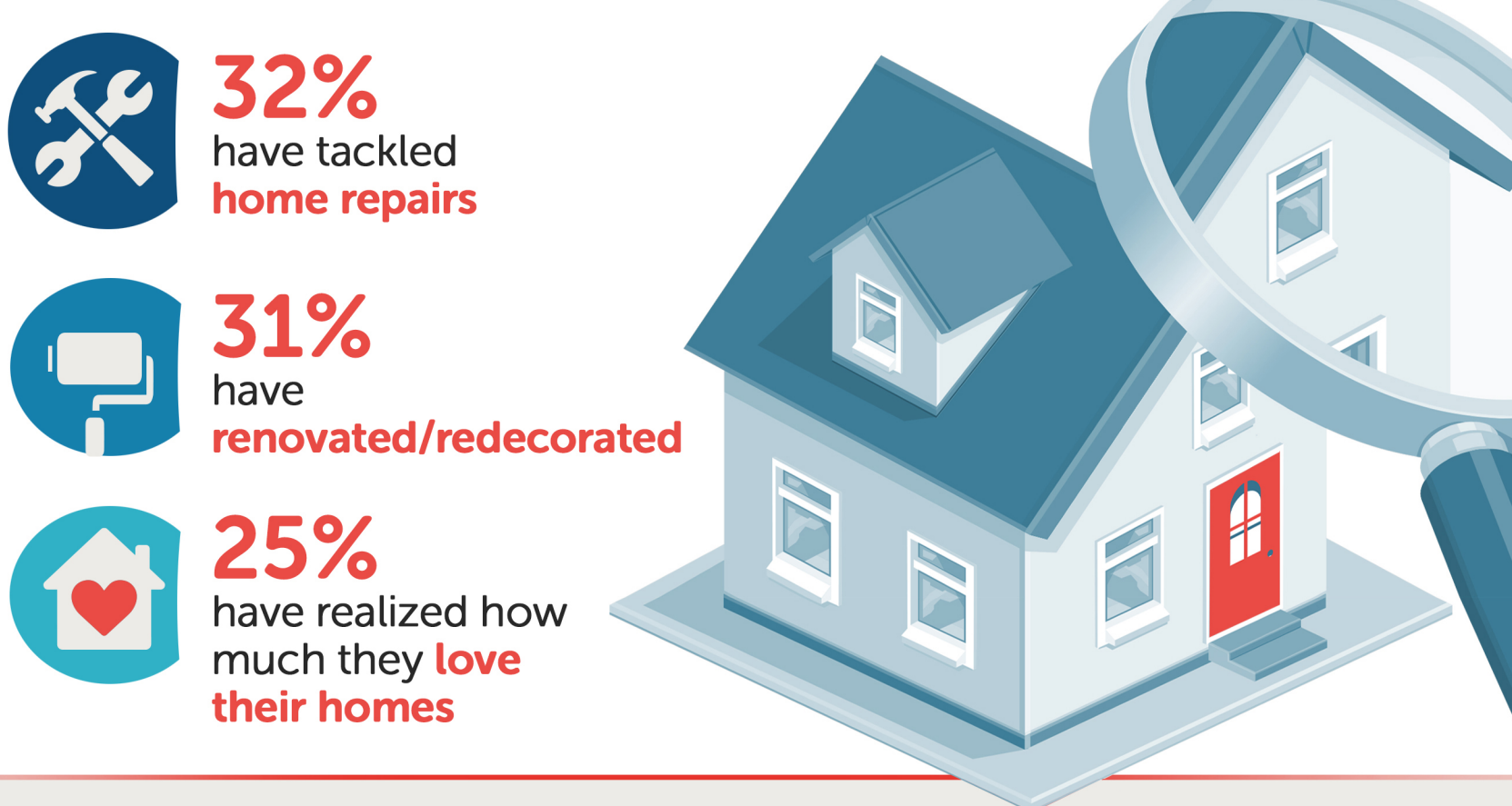
Due to COVID-19, Over 4 out of 10 Americans are Trying to Save More Than They Were Before the Pandemic.
